

## APPENDIX A.

### AGRICULTURE

#### Note on the construction of an annual index of purchases of inputs outside agriculture

$N+P_2O_5+K_2O$  content of mineral fertilizers and imports of machinery provide the most complete homogeneous annual indicators available. Unfortunately, the series for the content of mineral fertilizers starts in 1892, and it had to be extrapolated backwards to 1870 with a series of mineral fertilizer imports. Missing values for 1935-1939 and 1945-1950 were log-linearly interpolated from available data for 1935, 1945 and 1950. For 1940-1944 it was assumed the same value as for 1945. The available series for machinery imports covers 1879-1935. A machinery stock series was built up assuming an average life of 10 years. Fortunately, the small share of agricultural final output represented by purchases outside agriculture imply that the biases introduced by using these proxies are not very large.

For the years 1879-1935 yearly fluctuations for purchases outside agriculture were proxied by the supply of  $N+P_2O_5+K_2O$  in mineral fertilizers and the stock of agricultural machinery, and its geometric mean was linked to the 1913 benchmark (Vandellós (1925) estimate of 4.3 per cent of final output) and extrapolated backwards to 1870 with a series for imports of mineral fertilizers while for the years 1850-1870 the value for 1870 was assumed to remain constant. For 1936-1964, the 1964 National Accounts' benchmark (21.8 per cent of final output) was linked to a series of  $N+P_2O_5+K_2O$  content of mineral fertilizers.

Sources for  $N+P_2O_5+K_2O$  content of mineral fertilizers were Gallego (1987) and Barciela (1989), and imports of machinery derive from GEHR (1989).

For cattle and goats total dressed carcass weight/livestock number ratios for 1925-1935, and 1950 ratio

Estimates derived from Simpson (1989) who assumes that 28% and 38.3% of cattle and goats were sacrificed each year and Comín (1985a) who provides an average dressed carcass weight of 137.4 kg and 9.8 kg, respectively, produce slightly higher coefficients than those adopted.

For sheep the proportions were 62.7%, 23.4% and 25.8, respectively. For goat, 65.2%, 60%, 175, respectively.
